Key Dates

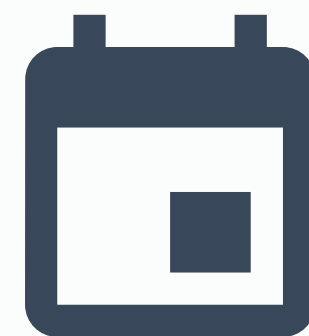
3 September - We welcome Y6 and Y7 onto site for induction days

Follow drop off procedure for your child's year group on Re-ConnectED

Parents of all pupils in Yrs 3-11 will be asked to remain in their cars for car park management

Non-uniform for the first 1/2 of term, including leggings, t-shirts, hoodies and trainers.

Clothes should be suitable for PE / Dance / Drama.

School coat and school bag required

We ask pupils to move efficiently away from drop-off zones

School Day and Curriculum

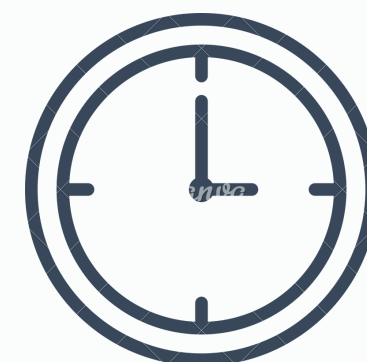
Each year group has a dedicated area of the school in which to work and play whilst maintaining social distancing

We have increased the travel time between lessons to allow for hand washing

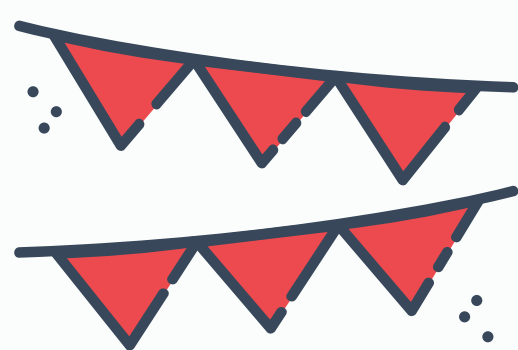
Specialist classrooms cleaned and disinfected between lessons
